VALUES FORMATION LESSONS IN THE PHILIPPINES

Few of us can imagine the depth of appreciation we feel for the efforts to help the chil-

dren of the Philippines. From the used textbooks to the hygiene kits for the children to the milk feeding program for under nourished children, and now the all new Values Formation curriculum for elementary school children; everything is so well received. It can only be that God is directing the ministry of ICP/His Offspring Ministries in the Philippines.

The teaching team reached about three hundred children with the three lesson series on honesty. School officials all expressed appreciation for the lessons. The children listened attentively and even did their homework as assigned!

When the curriculum was presented to Mayor Edwin Santiago and his chief-of-staff, they reacted with statements of the need for such a study for elementary and secondary students. There are an estimated twenty thousand elementary school children in our city of San Fernando alone.

The Character Code for Life curriculum was developed when ICP/His Offspring Ministries Director in the Philippines, Jeremiah Abay realized that the use of leftover VBS materials did not adequately meet the need. At the same time, the mayor was asking for something to help children understand their responsibilities to God, their families and their country.

We also appreciate Sister Jeanie Cash and all the others who have helped develope this test series. We see the opportunity to reach thousands of children in the coming years with the message of the saving power of the gospel of Christ as well as with the knowledge to develope a Christian worldview.
