ordinator Paul Van Hre has done a great job of getting the files to the print shop, setting up workshops for training and distribution of *CCFL* curriculum in Myanmar (Burma).

Thanks to ICP supporters, the children in ICP/Hope Children's Home in Myanmar have food and clothing.

The children come from the mountainous areas of northern Myanmar where the average annual income is less than \$200.00 per family. The Covid Virus has been especially hard on these families.

RICE FOR HUNGRY CHILDREN



Volunteers off-loaded one hundred sacks of rice from the transport truck. Others repackaged the contents into smaller bags of about twenty-two pounds each of rice for the children of 422 families who live behind the ICP office in San Fernando, on the Philippine island of Luzon. Jeremiah Abay, ICP Director, guided volunteer workers to repackage and distribute the rice. Special volunteer, Gearldene Canabe worked tirelessly to build a list of family names, children's names and addresses.

Together with a squad of police from the Regional Mobile Force, Battalion 3 the distribution was made. Because of social

distancing, each family was asked to place a chair in front of their door. The package of rice and clothing would be placed in the chair. After a prayer of thanksgiving, the workers delivered packages, each of which was assembled for a specific family. Jeremiah followed, passing out tracts and witnessing to the parents as they come to pick up their package.
