ICP AND CORONAVIRUS

The world of the ICP ministry has rapidly changed because of the infectious virus.

With the cancellation of travel, Rita and I along with Pastor Joseph Pemberton were unable to make the trip in March to the Philippines and Myanmar. This trip has been tentatively set for July.

Most of the activities planned for Myanmar will be done without us because the virus has had minimal effect on that country.

In the Philippines, the virus has caused many things to be canceled. Only essential retail stores remain open. Services in Amazing Grace Baptist Church, which meets in the ICP office building in the Philippines were at first planned, then canceled when the entire province was put

in "lockdown." Shopping malls are closed. Only essential retail stores such as grocery stores and drug stores remain open. Store shelves are basically bare. We were able to send funds for purchase of emergency supplies to Jeremiah, but the supplies laid in may prove inadequate. As funds become available to us, we will be able to do more to help with the anticipated needs for food and other vital necessities of the children in the Philippines.

The translators in both the Philippines and Myanmar will continue to do their work. During this shut down time, we hope to prepare several modules of the *Character Code for Life* curriculum to be printed and distributed when possible.

VBS NEED AND DISTRIBUTION

Searching around in the rooftop storage space at the rented office building where ICP offices are located, Jeremiah found about fifty VBS sample kits from years past. He contacted several pastors, and quickly a VBS distribution was planned. Sample kits and pupil books were distributed to about twenty-five churches in anticipation for VBS in April. Pictured at right are some of the pastors picking up their sample kits.

Vacation Bible School is very popular with the churches of the Philippines. All of the children look forward with eager anticipation to VBS. For several years, ICP provided materials in the Filipino language for thirty thousand children. However, there has been no VBS production since ICP began the *Character Code for Life* curriculum for Sunday school. This curriculum has been well received and many churches are using it. But pastors continue to ask for VBS materials.

For this reason we plan to produce a VBS curriculum to be translated into all the languages possible and made available for the children. Please join us in prayer that this may be accomplished in time for VBS 2021.

SPANISH-SPEAKING MISSIONS are taking advantage of the *Character Code for Life* curriculum. Mission churches in Mexico, Ecuador and Columbia have already begun using Module 1. Missionary Edgar Rubio, sponsored by First Landmark Baptist Church of Clarksville, Arkansas has materials to distribute in Ecuador and Columbia. In total, curriculum for over four hundred-fifty children (eighteen lessons each) has been distributed. First Baptist of Cave City, Arkansas and Grace Baptist of Jonesboro helped cover the cost of printing and delivering the curriculum.

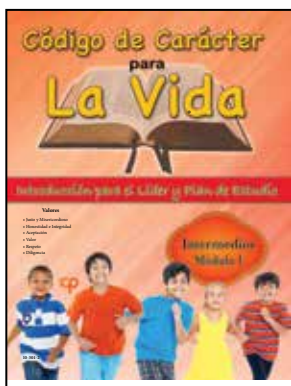
Preschool (ages 3 - 5) "placemats." (9.5"X13") Side 1 gives the Bible story, memory verse and selected projects for the children to do.

Character Code for Life Curriculum Overview

The curriculum is divided into three age levels: Preschool (age 3 - K), Primary (school grades 1 - 3) and Intermediate (grades 4 - 6). Each age group consists of six modules of eighteen lessons, to correlate with the child's school year. However, since the modules are not dated, they may be used consecutively, making a continuous two-year curriculum of one lesson per week. Each lesson of a module uses the same Bible story and memory verse for all three age levels.

Curriculum Components

1. Teacher's Lesson Guide — a thirty-six page booklet introducing the curriculum, including complete instructions for each of the three lessons on the six values discussed in each of the six modules in the curriculum.

2. Student's Leaflets — One leaflet for each classroom session. Each four page leaflet gives the Bible principle (value) and learner activities to help the child fix the value in his mind.

3. Visual Aids — A visual aid poster for each lesson session plus a bonus poster with the memory verses for the module. (19 posters)

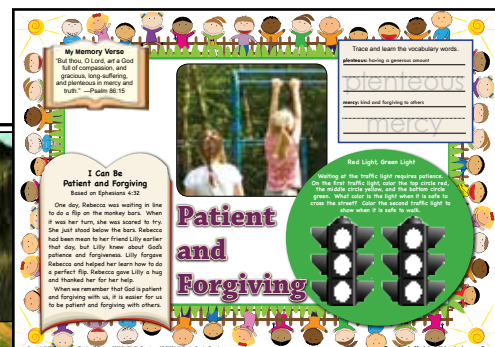
4. Primary Student Journal—To be kept in classroom for duration of the module. Contains space for pupil to make notes of each lesson, plus memory verse for each value.

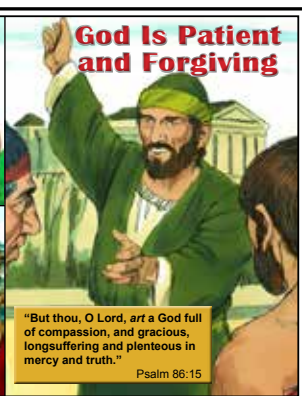
