Children will attend for six hours each day! They will use the ICP curriculum, *Lord of Kings* VBS along with the English-as-a-second-language program prepared by Brenda Jackson.

The ESL program uses the ICP *Character Code for Life* curriculum for its base reading materials. It is also recommended for ESL programs with Spanish and other languages. Junia commented that these "are tremendously awesome resources."

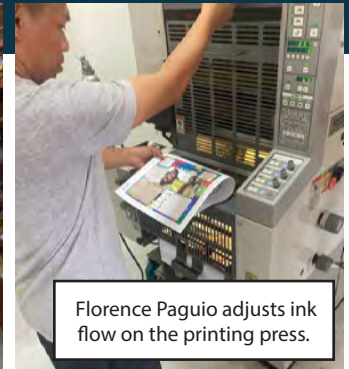

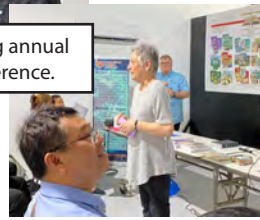

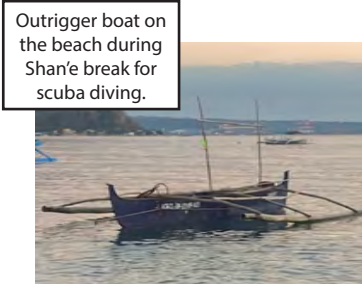

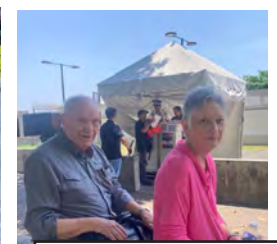
