BOOKS BEING PRINTED For Uganda and South Sudan

The recent funds which Brother Bill sent have enabled us to begin printing ICP literature for our churches in Uganda and South Sudan. We have already printed two hundred preschool copies.

We are still working on printing the books. We will be able to print a total of one thousand copies which will be sent to our churches in the two countries.


After sharing with them the tips on using the Swahili ICP literature, the teachers were eager to use the books.





FUNDS NEEDING FOR PRINTING
