## John's Notes

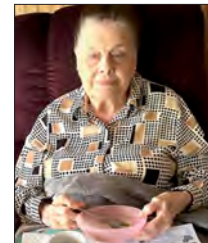
### DISTRIBUTION DAY:

The civil war continues to rage in Myanmar (Burma). This just came from Timothy, "Regrettably, the civil conflict raging across our nation has taken a turn for the worse. It pains me deeply to report that many of our fellow believers are enduring severe persecution. Some have suffered torture and even lost their lives, while others have seen their homes reduced to rubble by the actions of malevolent forces." Despite these serious problems, the ministry continues.

Jacob reported that his sons, Joseph and Joshua, are ready for their first experience of school. They will enroll in a nearby Christian school. Rita and I really miss getting to watch those two boys as they grow to be great men of God. They also continue to help Jacob distribute Bible study materials to churches in the area.

God has blessed the work in Myanmar. Although the war rages, the people are responding to the message of redemption in Christ. We have made plans to build a residence for Jacob and a warehouse/print shop for the ministry. Jacob has located a suitable lot and we were able to make the initial payment of \$3,000. Total price of the lot will be \$26,530.00. Jacob estimates that the house will cost about \$30,000. Please join us in prayer that God will soon provide the funds for this and the building. This will save greatly in the rent for Jacob's apartment and literature storage place.
