VBS by ICP is becoming a reality. Writers are completing their assignments and editors are reading manuscripts. Artists and designers are at work getting the first Vacation Bible School to be produced by International Christian Publishers a reality.

Translator Jacob Tubal is ready to translate the materials into the Burmese language. It will be the first time a full VBS curriculum will be available to help the children of Myanmar (Burma). If Covid-19 is past by summer of 2021, we should be able to supply materials for thirty thousand children in Myanmar.

Jeremiah Abay is anxiously waiting to get started translating the *Lord of the Kings* into Tagalog language for the children of the Philippine Islands. Having grown accustomed to VBS over the years, the churches there will surely need materials for more than thirty thousand children.

Lord of the Kings will focus on the Hebrew captives in Babylon. VBS students will learn how God stood by these young men who were faithful to Him. God protected His people while demonstrating His sovereignty over all kings of the earth.


Children will learn it is a good thing to give one's heart faithfully to worshiping and serving God, who is rich in mercy and love.

CHARACTER CODE FOR LIFE

Building a Church/Family Partnership



In an effort to help churches who are unable to have Sunday School because of Covid-19, and help families who want to continue training their children in the principles of godliness, ICP has adapted the *Character Code for Life* curriculum and the *God's Character and Me* curriculum for family Bible study time.

The values formation curriculum helps children learn important life values. There is a series of three lessons on each value. There are six values in each Module. The entire curriculum is composed of six Modules of eighteen lessons for three age groups making this a nine year program.

Churches order the materials and assemble custom packages for each family. (Picture at left.) Each family package should contain a teacher's guide, appropriate visuals and student materials for each child in the family. These family packages are picked up by parents or mailed to the family regularly. Some churches will elect to provide a "value set" of three lessons each week. Others will elect to provide just one lesson each week.

The materials may be easily adapted to either option.

Parents will find the materials easy to use. Preschool age children will enjoy the placemats, which are filled with Bible stories, illustrations and pictures to color. Children in grades 1-3 will find the student cards easy to read and instructive. The Bible story is interesting and the exercises are educationally sound. Older youngsters in grades 4-6 will enjoy reading the biographies of Bible characters. Each lesson leaflet has instructive exercises sure to capture attention. There is a memory verse for each value.
