COVID and the civil war continue to have dramatic impact on the work of helping children learn about our Lord in Myanmar (Burma). Jacob's parents have laid up supplies in a jungle hideout in the event of their remote village being destroyed by the military government soldiers. Bombs are continuously bursting near his apartment in Yangon. But Jacob continues to translate the Lord of Kings VBS in preparation for printing and distributing the first VBS curriculum to some 40 churches to use in the summer of 2022. Now that the seminary has re-opened, Jacob is teaching classes in expository preaching and the book of Romans.

Since the death of ICP coordinator, Paul, we will partner with Timothy Mang to distribute the CCfL and VBS curriculums. Timothy will also be directing the Missionary Training School which is a ministry of ICP.

Than Tlang is a town of about ten thousand people, mostly Christians in Chin State, Burma. Last week, terrorists attacked the town, shooting people and bombing their houses. Nineteen houses were burned. A young Baptist pastor was shot and killed while trying to extinguish burning houses. The terrified people fled to Mizoram State, India. Only 235 people remain in the town: one children's home (25 people) led by an evangelist, another evangelist's family and another Christian family. All the houses are empty now. On the way, while running for safety, many people faced a lot of difficulties. May I request you to pray for these brethren. — Timothy Mang
