Character Code for Life Bible Curriculum

Overview

The curriculum is divided into three age levels: Preschool (age 3-K), Primary (grades 1-3) and Intermediate (grades 4-6). Each age group consists of six modules of eighteen lessons, to correlate with the child's school year. However, since the modules are not dated, they may be used consecutively, making a continuous two-year curriculum of one lesson per week. Each lesson of a module uses the same Bible story and memory verse for all three age levels.

Components

Leader's Lesson Plans — Includes complete instructions for each of the eighteen lessons for the module.

Visual Aids — A visual aid poster for each lesson plus a poster with the memory verses for the module. (19 posters)

Students' Materials —

Intermediate Leaflets – Four-page leaflets that give the Bible principle (value) and activities to help the learner retain the value studied.

Primary Cards -8.5" x 5.5" cards that include the Bible principle (value) and activities to help the reinforce the value studied.

Primary Student Journal - Additional activities to accompany the lessons.

Preschool Placemats – Provides the Bible principle (value), coloring page and activities to help the child understand and remember the lessons.







Lessons will focus on the life of Daniel and his friends. The five lessons will present

Scripture showing how God gave victories over the kings' orders, the lions' teeth, the furnace's heat, the idol's demands and the cultural rules of a harsh world. Like Daniel and his friends, boys and girls will learn how to live in peace with those who do not understand their commitment to God's moral standards.

The children of the world enjoy Vacation Bible School. Churches in most of the countries served by ICP can easily find workers eager to help children learn about Jesus. In the last few years, while we concentrated on development of the *Character Code for Life* curriculum, we have produced no VBS curriculum. We hope to change this for 2021.




